### **Neighborhood Stabilization Program 2**

The City of Youngstown is making an application to the US Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for \$32.42 million in Neighborhood Stabilization Program 2 funds in partnership with the cities of Warren, Niles, Newton Falls, McDonald, Girard, Struthers, Campbell and Lowellville. The NSP2 application outlines a strategy to achieve the program goals of arresting the decline and stabilizing neighborhoods. The strategy will use a varied collection of eligible activities to achieve these goals including: acquisition and rehabilitation of foreclosed property, land banking, housing finance assistance, redevelopment, and demolition.

The purpose of the comment period is to allow citizens the opportunity to review and comment on the proposed covered activities for the application prior to its submission to HUD. The application will be submitted July 16, 2009. Comments must be received by 4:00 pm on July 14, 2009. Please note this is a draft application only, and is subject to change.
